Corvette racing teams finished 4th and 5th after qualifying 7th and 8th at Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship.

The Motorsports Park is now offering driving instruction which includes three class sessions and three 20 minute track sessions for \$599.

Go-cart rental also available at the Motorsports Park for \$20 a session.

National Corvette Museum membership benefits include free admission to the museum, 10% discount on merchandise from Corvette store and catalog, Discount on insurance from NCM Insurance Agency, GM Supplier Discount on GM vehicles, discounts on car rentals and hotels, and 20% discount on CARFAX reports.

Museum in Motion (MiM) California Dreamin tour Aug 18 to 23 starts in Kingman, AZ and ends in Long Beach, CA at the Queen Mary Floating Ocean liner Hotel. The cost is \$1750 for driver and \$600 for alternate driver, but registration has closed.

Breck just replaced the plastic radiator reserve tank in one of his Corvettes. He said the parts slide together but the old tank can be difficult to pull apart.

2014s and later may have faulty factory wheel alignments which will cause tires to need replacement after a few thousand miles. He recommends an alignment at Watson Chevrolet because they are the only place that has the specifications, training and the correct tools.
